

## **We are delighted to welcome you back to Snowsports!**

We would however like to ask you to adhere to the following protocols and general arrangements. These rules will help keep both Adventure Aberdeen staff and customers safe. Adventure Aberdeen staff will be on hand to support you and monitor adherence to social distancing guidelines.

This has been developed in conjunction with the most recent Snowsports Scotland COVID-19 guidance.

- Anyone with any symptoms of COVID-19 should not participate and should self-isolate themselves in-line with Government Guidelines.
- Please arrive no more than 10 minutes ahead of booking. Observe physical distancing measures at all times and use the hand sanitiser provided.
- Face coverings must be worn in our venue circulation areas and changing areas. We would also encourage the use of them during activities.
- Please arrive ready for your session and bring your own water. Changing rooms will be limited or may be unavailable at this time, please check ahead of your booking.
- No social gatherings are permitted. Once your session is finished, please leave the premises promptly.
- For school, group or club bookings, the leader is responsible for recording all attendees including contact numbers for Test and Protect purposes and must send the registers to the venue.

## **Guidance Rules**

### **Snowsport Scotland Guidance**

- **Ensure group sizes are no more than 30 participants on each session (slope). Excluding coaches and officials where applicable**
- **For anyone over 12 taking part in outdoor activity, a 'field of play bubble' allows physical distancing to be suspended during the activity/session. Physical distancing still applies before and after the activity/session.**
- **Skiers and Boarders are encouraged to use their own equipment**
- **Organised Events & Competitions - These can take place, where the necessary risk assessment and mitigating actions have been carried out by a Club COVID Officer**
- **Use of changing rooms and showering facilities should be avoided where possible, although from the 31 August 2020 they may be made available for participants with disabilities or special needs or when immediate changing is required.**
- **No spectating should take place other than where a parent is supervising a child or vulnerable adult. Physical distancing guidance should always be followed.**

### **Adventure Aberdeen Guidance**

- **Clubs must provide the requested SA requirements in order to secure their booking.**
- **No spectators are permitted slope side apart from where supervising a child or vulnerable adult cannot be avoided.**
- **Skiers and Boarders are encouraged to use their own equipment. Sport Aberdeen will loan equipment which will be thoroughly cleaned after each use.**
- **Always observe physical distancing rules following your arrival at the venue and adhere to our one-way system through the building. Keep left on outdoor pathways.**
- **Arrive ready for your session. If using personal ski boots and hire of our skis is required, please have your ski boots ready to be handed to our technicians for fitting.**
- **Regularly wash your hands using hand sanitiser, and avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.**
